

## Right of Way Process Currently Underway



• 200+ property owners (commercial and residential) notified of access needs and surveys

- Begin outreach and letters to impacted landowners
- Begin appraisals and interviews with property owners
- Continue outreach and letters to impacted landowners through June 2018
- Continue appraisals and interviews with property owners
- Estimated 75-90 days between appraisals and offers for properties
- Acquisition negotiations

### **292 Acquisitions - 10 Residential Relocations**






Construction Ramp Up Spring 2018



Construction will begin in the priority areas shown at November 2017 Design Public Hearings within VDOT Right of Way:

- Long term lane shifts
- Tree removal where necessary within existing right of way
- Erosion and Sediment Control Setup
- Utility Relocation








## **Construction Ramp Up**



### Spring 2018







- The completed I-66 project will include Intelligent Transportation System components
- During construction, transitioning to 4 lanes and emergency pull-off areas
- Retaining limited key features of Active Traffic Management (ATM) system during construction
- Salvaging ATM equipment where possible
- Phased transition beginning Spring 2018

## Noise, Traffic, and Environmental Analysis Process Spring 2018



Based on design plans & updated traffic studies

- Is the wall feasible?
- Is the wall reasonable?
- Publish final noise study results and noise wall locations in Spring 2018
- Solicit input from benefited property owners & renters (voting process for new walls)
- Include approved noise walls into final plans

# Final Traffic and Environmental

**Noise Analysis** 

Final

- Final Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) completed in June 2016 documented the Preferred Alternative design
- Project design changes undergoing environmental re-evaluation
- Results of the traffic and environmental reevaluations and the Final Design Noise Analysis will be posted to Transform66.org (late Spring 2018)





