Virginia Food Crop Donation Tax Credit Guidelines: Let's Help One Another Save Time and Money and Feed Virginia

## How it Works

You will receive a tax credit of **30% of the fair market value** of your donated crop off of your Virginia state taxes

The maximum amount you may receive is \$5,000 per year

Any **unused tax credits** may be used in the future for up to 5 years

In order to receive the tax credit, you must **donate to a food bank** located in Virginia

**Only Virginia farmers** are eligible to receive this tax credit

## What We Do

The **food bank appraises the fair market value** of the produce; based on that week's estimated value given by the VDACS

The food bank will prepare and provide form (FCD-2) within 30 days of the donation demonstrating the amount of food donated and value

The food bank will provide **volunteers to collect donated produce** at market

## What You Do

You must **be the one growing** the produce in order to receive the tax credit.

**Once a year** you submit your forms (FCD-1 and FCD-2's) to the Virginia Department of Taxation by **Feb. 1**<sup>st</sup>.
