

### Status of 2019 Work Program



#### Total of 38% have been adopted and 44% are in progress

### **Major Accomplishments**

- zMOD Consolidated Draft posted June 30, 2020
  - Addresses many outstanding Priority 2 items
- Community Gardens
- Outdoor Lighting
- Regional Mall Parking Rates
- Adult Day Care Centers targeted for completion this year





**Proposed 2020 Work Program Timing** 13 main initiatives with 20 individual topic areas

- **First Tier** Research and present to LUPC within the first half of FY2021, or potentially authorized/adopted in that timeframe
- Second Tier Targeted for second half of FY2021
- **TBD** Not specified or may extend into FY2022
