



## Policy Recommendations

Factors to determine Objective Reasonableness in the Non-Criminal Context:

- Where a situation does not fit within the <u>Graham</u> test because the person in question has not committed a crime, is not resisting arrest, and is not directly threatening the officer:
- 1. Was the person experiencing a medical emergency that rendered him incapable of making a rational decision under circumstances that posed an immediate threat of serious harm to himself or others?
- 2. Was some degree of force reasonably necessary to ameliorate the immediate threat?
- 3. Was the force used more than reasonably necessary under the circumstances (i.e., was it excessive)?

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## **Policy Recommendations**


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- Revert back to the term "Non-deadly" Force

### Investigation Review Status

In addition to responding to public complaints, the Office of the Independent Police Auditor monitors and reviews Fairfax County Police Department (FCPD) internal investigations into:

- officer involved shootings
- deaths while in custody of the FCPD
- use of force cases resulting in death or serious injury
- other use of force cases when a public complaint is received
