Summary of Highlights from April to June 2010

### **Capital Program Highlights**

- 13 projects were completed since March 2010: Centreville Road (West Ox Road to Frying Pan Road), Arlington Blvd/Olin Drive, Dolley Madison Blvd/Great Falls St/Lewinsville Road, Lee Jackson Highway Walkway, Leesburg Pike/Dranesville Road, Leesburg Pike/Glen Carlyn Road, Leesburg Pike/Magarity Road, Lewinsville Road/Balls Hill Road, Little River Tpke/ Backlick Road, Roberts Road Walkway, McLearen Road Walkway, Wolftrap Road Walkway and Jefferson Avenue Walkway.
- 11 projects are under construction: I-495 Capital Beltway HOT Lanes, I-95 Fourth-Lane Widening, Woodrow Wilson Bridge (includes Route 1 and Telegraph Road interchanges), Route 123 at Waverly Way, Georgetown Pike Stone Rubble Masonry Signs, Burke Centre Pkwy/Roberts Pkwy, Fairfax County Parkway EPG, Fairfax County Pkwy/Fair Lakes Blvd/Monument Drive Interchange, South Kings Highway/Harrison Lane, Spring Hill Road, and Dulles Rail (Phase I).

#### **Innovative Project Design and Delivery**

- Capital Beltway HOT Lanes PPTA Construction continues on the entire section of I-495 from the Springfield Interchange to just north of the Dulles Toll Road. Currently, more than 50 bridges, overpasses, and interchanges are under construction including bridge demolition, installation of steel and bridge decks, and utility relocation. Sound wall construction continues throughout the 28 mile corridor (14 miles in each direction). Major traffic switches and/or lane closures have taken place at Braddock Road, Gallows Road, Arlington Boulevard, Lee Highway, I-66, Oak Street, and Route 123 interchanges/overpasses. Scheduled for July is the reopening of the Oak Street overpass and the closure of the Idlywood Road overpass. For further information, www.VAmegaprojects.com
- Route 28 PPTA Construction is substantially complete on the "final four" interchanges: Route 28/Innovation (partial interchange), Route 28/Willard Road and Route 28/Frying Pan Road (Fairfax County), and Route 28/Nokes Blvd (Loudoun County). In July 2009, funding was authorized for design only to widen three segments of Route 28 to 4 lanes: SB Sterling Blvd to Dulles Toll Road, NB McLearen Road to Dulles Toll Road, and SB Dulles Toll Road to Route 50.

#### **Dulles Rail**

- Construction activities are underway along the entire 11-mile alignment of Phase 1 from
  the West Falls Church Metrorail Station to the Dulles Connector Road, through Tysons
  and west to Wiehle Avenue in Reston. The ramp that connects southbound Route 123 to
  Route 7 is open to westbound Route 7 traffic only. This new pattern will be in effect for
  approximately three years. Along Route 7, mid-block left turns are being removed. The
  right lane of SB Route 123 between Scotts Crossing Road and the I-495 Capital Beltway
  Inner Loop is now closed, and will remain so for approximately two years. Construction
  is in progress in the Dulles International Airport Access Highway median. For further

- The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is funding the new Tysons Connector shuttle bus service that provides free rides to and from office buildings, condos and apartments, Tysons Corner Center and Tysons Galleria. The service began in late November 2009, and is operated by the Fairfax Connector bus system.

Summary of Highlights from April to June 2010

#### **Special Programs Highlights**

#### **Pedestrian Program**

 Pedestrian Access and Safety: FCDOT staff continued on-going outreach and coordination with groups such as the Trails and Sidewalks Committee and the Hunter Mill District Transportation Advisory Council, and at special events such as the FCPS Special Education Conference, the Earth Day Expo and the Live Well Employee Health & Fitness Day.

#### **Bicycle Program**

- Wolftrap Road Bike/Ped. Bridge: Construction is 100% complete. A ribbon cutting ceremony was held on June 19, 2010.
- On-Road Bike Lane Initiative: Six miles of on-road bike lanes were completed in summer 2009. Work is continuing on additional roadway segments including: Wakefield Chapel Road (funded as part of the hot lanes project), Westmoreland Street Phase II, Hunter Village Drive, and Gallows Road Phase II. New segments will include: Sleepy Hollow Road, Fort Hunt Road, and Huntington Avenue. This is a cooperative program between FCDOT and VDOT.
- County Bicycle Parking Policy and Guidelines: Staff is completing work on the
  development of the County bicycle parking standards. This document will provide
  guidance to both the development community and governmental agencies responsible
  for the design, installation and maintenance of bicycle racks and facilities. It will also
  define parking ratios based on land uses.
- Increase and Enhance Bicycle Parking: 150 bicycle racks were purchased and
  delivered in December 2009. The racks are the inverted "U" style rack and will be
  installed at locations countywide including the Town of Vienna and Town of Herndon.
  Rack installation was initiated on June 23, beginning with visitor parking at the
  Courthouse/Judicial Center. Staff is currently preparing a bid document for the purchase
  of 48 new bicycle lockers.
- Vienna Metro-City of Fairfax-GMU Connector: Work has begun on a bicycle route connecting GMU with Vienna Metro via the City of Fairfax. This is a cooperative project with the City of Fairfax, George Mason University, and the NVRPA. Two rides have been scheduled in order to define alternative routes and signing needs.
- Metrorail Station Area Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements Study: This study identifies bicycle parking needs, access improvements, and safety at the region's Metrorail stations. Two stations in Fairfax County were chosen as part of this study; Vienna and Huntington. This study is being managed by WMATA in coordination with FCDOT, DPZ, and other stakeholders. The study was completed in spring 2010.
- **Bike the Sites Map:** FCDOT was awarded a transportation enhancement grant for FY2010 to complete a bicycle map that highlights a route along historic Civil War sites in Fairfax County. This allocation will also fund the installation of way finding signage and interpretive markers along the bicycle route. While Federal approval was granted in September 2009, staff is awaiting State authorization, anticipated in late summer 2010.

Summary of Highlights from April to June 2010

- **Bicycle Master Plan Study:** As requested by the Board, staff has prepared a request for proposals (RFP) for our on-call consultants to prepare a Bicycle Master Plan Study. Negotiations have been initiated with the consultant and Notice to Proceed is anticipated in July. The study will be phased with the first segment focusing on the Tysons Corner area. Work is anticipated to begin in summer 2010.
- **Bicycle Route Signage-Dranesville District:** Staff is currently preparing sign plans for bike routes in three locations in the Dranesville District.
- Bobann Drive Bikeway- Sully District: Scoping and preliminary design has been initiated on the Bobann Drive Bikeway. Approximately one mile in length, this shared use path will provide direct non-motorized access to the Stringfellow Road Park and Ride lot from the Centreville and Fair Lakes areas. (funded for PE only)

#### **Traffic Operations and R-TAP**

- The intersection of Route 7 and Lewinsville Road experiences significant congestion during the peak operating hours of the McLean Bible Church, typically occurring Sunday mornings and early afternoons. The congestion results in long queues of traffic along Route 7 and vehicles queued through multiple cycles before clearing the intersection. An ongoing analysis in conjunction with the Dranesville District office, Police Department and representatives of the McLean Bible Church is underway to improve the operations of Route 7 as well as the ingress and egress of Church-related traffic.
- VDOT, with the support of the Board, submitted a request to FHWA to open the HOV-only ramps on I-66 at Stringfellow Road and Monument Drive to non-HOV traffic during the off-peak hours to improve the congestion and connectivity of I-66 and the adjoining road network. FHWA's most recent request for an Interchange Modification Report (IMR) is being explored and evaluated by VDOT, and at the request of the Board, staff will provide support to VDOT in their subsequent analyses.
- In conjunction with WMATA, VDOT and DRPT, staff is exploring a concept study to
  provide the real-time occupancy of Metro and other parking facilities to I-66 and other
  outlets, directing commuters to facilities with available parking and reducing congestion
  on I-66 and other roadways. Currently, a concept plan for a pilot program and cost
  estimates are being developed as a funding source has not yet been identified.
- Staff has been asked to study and make recommendations regarding traffic operations and transportation improvements in the Lorton area, particularly along Lorton Road between Silverbrook Road and Lorton Market Street
- In the second quarter of 2010, seven traffic calming projects were initiated for study. Three projects were approved by the Board.

#### **Tysons Corner Planning Studies**

• The Tysons Corner Comprehensive Plan Amendment was approved by the BOS on June 22, 2010. By 2050, Tysons Corner will be transformed into a walkable, green, urban center based on a plan approved by the BOS that updates the land use plan and Zoning Ordinance for Tysons. The Board also adopted 20 follow-on motions to guide progress. The plan envisions Tysons as home to up to 100,000 residents and 200,000 jobs by 2050. Because the plan was designed to take advantage of the 4 new Metro stations coming to Tysons in 2013, 75% of future growth will be within a half mile of these stations.

Summary of Highlights from April to June 2010

- The Dulles Toll Road (DTR) Ramps Study will look at new ramp connections between the DTR and Tysons that will help move traffic in and out of Tysons Corner. Staff is currently developing the RFP for an operational study, which will be followed by a study of preliminary design.
- The Grid of Streets study will look at how Tysons can be transformed into a walkable urban center through redevelopment of land and a corresponding grid of streets that would offer alternative streets for travel within Tysons. A planning level study is complete and further study of operations and preliminary design is planned for fall 2010.

#### **Bus Stop Safety and Access (Bus Stop Improvement Program)**

- Fairfax County places a priority on providing safe access to efficient transportation
  options including pedestrian amenities and transit service. A comprehensive inventory
  and study of all bus stops in Fairfax County identified undesirable bus stop conditions for
  priority action. The Board has identified \$2.5 million from the general fund and \$7.75
  million in the 2007 Transportation Bond for improvements to the priority stops identified
  in the study.
- 73 sites have been completed since implementing the program. There are currently 129 sites in design, 25 in land acquisition and 11 under construction.

#### **Bus Shelter Advertising Program**

 FCDOT intends to engage in a public/private partnership to aid in the improvement of bus stops, which is expected to raise revenues through the sale of advertising space on bus shelters. The contractor will sell advertising space to subsidize construction, maintenance, and operation of bus shelters, and will share a percentage of the surplus revenues with the County. The contract award is anticipated by mid-July 2010.

#### Fleet Expansion and Replacement of Older Buses with Cleaner Buses

- Fairfax Connector is committed to improving its fleet of passenger vehicles. Fairfax Connector has added 107 new transit vehicles to date with "Clean Diesel" buses, which are low-floor and more easily accessible than the older vehicles.
- Twenty-four older buses have been re-built so that additional service life can be realized.
- Fairfax Connector received 31 "Clean Diesel" buses in 2009. The buses received included the EMP system, which classifies them as Mini-Hybrids. Fairfax Connector anticipates buying an additional 16 to 18 of these buses in 2010/2011 as expansion buses to be utilized in support of TDP and Dulles Rail.

#### **Transit Development Plan (TDP) Activities**

- Consultant staff completed draft reports on several ancillary tasks to review Fairfax
   Connector public information materials and methods of presentation and transmission.
- FCDOT staff began to develop a scope of work for a new task to generate a Transit Development Plan document in the format mandated by DRPT.
- In FY2010, several TDP recommendations were implemented on various Fairfax Connector routes, including additional service on routes 621, 622 and 623 and modifications to RIBS 4. In FY2011, TDP-recommended modifications are being planned for routes 151 and 152.

Summary of Highlights from April to June 2010

#### **Transit Studies**

- In conjunction with planning for the I-95/I-395 HOT Lanes Project, an I-95/I-395
  HOV/HOT Lanes Transit/TDM Study was initiated in 2007 at the request of the Secretary
  of Transportation, managed by DRPT. Staff is currently working with the project team to
  develop park and ride and transit facilities in the corridor in fulfillment of the HOT lane
  project commitments.
- An I-66 Corridor Transit/TDM Study to optimize short-term corridor bus transit service and define elements of potential Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service was completed and a Draft Final Report issued in December 2009. Staff is currently working with the State and advisory group to develop short and medium term transit service and facility recommendations for the corridor.
- In 2008, a transit circulator study for the Springfield activity center was completed as an element of the Springfield Connectivity Study. A transit circulator study for the Tyson's Corner Urban Center began in summer 2009 in conjunction with replanning efforts underway for Tyson's.

#### **West Ox Bus Operations Center**

- The County's West Ox Bus Operations Center is in full operation as of late June 2009 with revenue service being operated by both the County's Fairfax Connector bus service and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority's Metrobus service.
- In November 2009, five routes operating in the I-66 corridor were transferred from the Herndon Garage to the West Ox Garage. This transfer resulted in reduced deadhead time and mileage.

#### **SPOT Transportation (Special Populations Transportation)**

- Seniors On-The-Go! and TaxiAccess are two user-side subsidy taxicab programs managed by FCDOT's Special Populations Transportation programs (SPOT).
- From April 1<sup>st</sup> to June 24<sup>th</sup>, the Seniors On-the-Go! registered 46 new participants, for a cumulative total of 4,984 registrants since the program's inception in 2001. 924 coupon booklets were sold during this period with a street value of \$ 30,492.
- TaxiAccess registered 4 new participants in the same time period, for a cumulative total
  of 555 registrants since the program's inception in 2007. 170 coupon booklets were
  sold, with a street value of \$ 5,610.
- The SPOT staff also continued distribution of free Senior SmarTrip cards to older adults for use on the local fixed route transit system (bus and rail). Since the beginning of the distribution, Senior SmarTrip cards have been distributed free to over 582 seniors.

#### **Transportation Demand Management (TDM) and Mixed-Use Development**

 The County has integrated Transportation Demand Management (TDM) strategies into the land development process and is working to formalize this program. TDM proffers promote alternatives to single occupant vehicle trips. These proffers contain commitments to provide TDM services, goals for percentage trip reduction, and remedies or penalties for non-attainment of proffered goals. The TDM proffer coordinator is negotiating proffers and monitoring implementation and performance of existing proffers.

Summary of Highlights from April to June 2010

- A consultant study on integrating TDM into the land use and approval process is near completion. In fall 2010, the study and recommendations will be completed and discussed in one or more public presentations. If adopted, the study recommendations will lead to more effective TDM strategies and formal arrangements for TDM proffers.
- Preliminary findings from the TDM study were used to inform the TDM and Parking sections of the land use plan and zoning ordinance amendments approved for Tysons Corner.

#### **Telework and Outreach**

- The Fairfax County government telework program currently has 1,396 employee participants, and continues to encourage teleworking countywide.
- The Fairfax County Employer Services Program (FCESP) partners with major employers, developers and multi-family complexes to promote and encourage alternative commute options. To date, 207 Fairfax County employers have implemented a Level 3 or 4 transportation benefits program, and another 197 employers have implemented a Level 1 or 2 program. Level 1 and 2 programs may include commuter surveys and/or supplying data for a commuter/employee density plot, distributing transit information, implementing alternative work schedules, or hosting an on-site transportation fair. Level 3 and 4 programs may include shuttles to/from transit stations, implementing formal telework programs, offering transit subsidies, providing free or premium parking to carpools and vanpools, or implementing a comprehensive bike/walk program.
- The FCESP is also supporting the Congestion Mitigation Program for Dulles Rail, HOT Lanes and BRAC construction by coordinating employer and community outreach with regional partners, including VDRPT, VDOT, DATA, TyTran and TAGS.

### **Traffic Flow, Signals, and Congestion Management**

- A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) is in place for the Capital Beltway HOT Lanes and other Northern Virginia Megaprojects to reduce congestion during construction. This includes incentives to reduce demand and promote alternative travel modes. The Tysons Connector midday free lunch shuttle operates in and around Tysons Corner. Motorists can now view real time traffic information, bus schedules, and construction activities via the Traveler Information Displays installed throughout Tysons Corner. The Megaprojects Employer Solutions team is actively meeting with employers to promote commuter solutions including Telework.
- Real time freeway monitoring system for Interstates 66, 395 and 95: The application
  has been deployed and is in daily use. Supplemental tools in use include the NCR's
  regional integrated transportation information system (RITIS); and, the I-95 Corridor
  Coalition's INRIX travel time protocol.
- The construction of the traffic signal at Sunrise Valley Drive and Frying Pan Road is complete. The traffic signal was put into operation in mid-April, over a month ahead of the anticipated completion date of May 31.

Summary of Highlights from April to June 2010

#### **Incident Management**

- VDOT Regional Operations continues to work with the Virginia State Police and Fairfax County Police regarding quick clearance protocol, and has recently engaged Fire Chief Rohr on this matter also.
- For emergency response, VDOT has initiated a Duty Officer construct which requires
  executive management personnel to be on-call for highway, weather, and planned
  incidents. Depending on the nature of an incident, the Duty Officer may initiate a VDOT
  incident command at PSTOC, which includes representation from VSP, VDOT
  maintenance, operations, and public affairs as well as coordination with Fairfax County
  Police and Fire.
- Incident Management Task Group (Fairfax County Police, Fire and Rescue, Virginia State Police and towing companies): Starting January 2010, VDOT Regional Operations re-initiated a monthly first responder coordination meeting at PSTOC to review highway incidents and identify improvement opportunities. The incident management task group will continue, and ultimately be merged with the monthly meeting.
- Comprehensive evacuation plans: VDOT Regional Operations is providing technical assistance and support to VDEM who are the recipient of a UASI Grant of approximately \$1.5M to investigate emergency evacuation on the NOVA arterial network. This work is a follow-on to that completed for Routes 50 and 1. The objective is to identify appropriate traffic signal strategies. Work began in December 2009.
- PSTOC and 911: A December 2009 'introduction' meeting was held with VDOT
  Regional Operations at PSTOC that included Fairfax County Fire and Rescue, Fairfax
  County Police, Fairfax County 911, and VSP managers to begin the process
  of coordination on matters such as highway incidents, weather incidents, and planned
  events. Since the 911, Police, and Fire Dispatch groups have only been in the PSTOC a
  few months, it is expected that there will be continued efforts to institutionalize activities.
- Pre-Disaster Recovery Task Force: Fairfax County has received funding from the Department of Homeland Security's Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI), to prepare a Pre-Disaster Recovery Planning project. FCDOT is working as part of the leadership team, along with other county agencies and community partners. The final project will provide a template for future, long-term regionalized disaster recovery planning and a single reference for guiding policy and action during this long-term recovery. In summary, the recovery plan will: (1) provide County leaders with goals, priorities, and action to accelerate and streamline Fairfax County's recovery to full functionality; (2) solidify the Office of Emergency Management's strategy for handling disasters at all four phases, as outlined in the Emergency Operations Plan (EOP); and (3) the Plan will support the County's regional partners (NCR) recovery efforts after a regional disaster.

#### **Other Projects**

 AF to RW Third Track Reconstruction Project: VDRPT, VRE, and CSX, working with Amtrak and the Federal Railroad Administration, identified six projects to increase passenger rail capacity and reliability between Richmond and Washington, D.C. Five of the six projects are complete, and the final project is in progress. This project will construct seven miles of third main line track north of the Franconia-Springfield VRE station and add signal system components. Construction is expected to be complete by summer 2010.
