



Project Background

- Part of Jefferson Manor Master Plan (1992)
- Locally Funded Project: Est. Project Cost = \$2.6 Million
- Proposed roadway and drainage improvements will meet VDOT Standards, for VDOT maintenance
- Pedestrian facility will meet VDOT & County Standards for maintenance and for ADA accessibility compliance.

Existing Conditions:

Albemarle Drive / Edgehill Drive


- Substandard Width Sidewalks
- Lack of Drainage Infrastructure
- Existing Utility Poles in Sidewalk
- Private Retaining Walls Leaning into Sidewalk Space






Proposed Improvements:

- New 5' Wide Sidewalks
- Install ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) Accessible Curb Ramps
- VDOT Standard Curb & Gutter
- New VDOT Standard Concrete Steps
- New Concrete Driveway Aprons
- Install Storm Sewer/Drainage System
- Roadway Pavement and Striping
- Maintain Existing On-Street Parking




Proposed Typical Sections:

Albemarle Drive (Rte. 1614) 1 Lane Curb Section




Retaining Walls:

 Existing retaining walls will be removed within VDOT right-of-way and reconstructed on private property, as coordinated with property owners during land acquisition.



Custom Stone Retaining Wall (Not to be Maintained by VDOT)



Other Improvements:

- Relocation and/or Upgrade of Existing Utilities (underground and overhead)
 - Dominion Electric Pole Relocations completed in 2018
 - Fairfax Water Main Upgrades completed in 2018
 - Washington Gas Main Relocations completed in 2019
 - Additional Fairfax Water and Washington Gas service line adjustments will be completed during construction
- Upgrade Street Lighting

Sequence of Construction:


Phase 1:

Install temporary travel and/or parking lane closures on Edgehill Drive and Albemarle Drive. Maintain one lane of traffic on Edgehill Drive and Albemarle Drive.

Perform site clearing (tree removal) operations. Construct drainage, utility adjustments, retaining walls, curb & gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps, driveway entrances, and steps.

Duration: Approximately 3-4 months

Length of Closure: Approximately 400 Feet




Sequence of Construction:

Phase 2:

Install temporary travel and/or parking lane closures on Albemarle Drive. Maintain one lane of traffic along Albemarle Drive.

Construct drainage, utility adjustments, retaining walls, curb and gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps, driveway entrances, and steps. Install signage and complete final roadway paving and re-striping.

Duration: Approximately 5-6 months Length of Closure: Approximately 900 Feet



Sequence of Construction:


Phase 2 (Cont'd):

Install temporary travel and/or parking lane closures on Albemarle Drive. Maintain one lane of traffic along Albemarle Drive.

Construct drainage items, utility adjustments, retaining walls, curb and gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps, driveway entrances, and steps. Install signage and complete final roadway paving and re-striping.

Duration: Approximately 5-6 months

Length of Closure: Approximately 900 Feet



Construction Impacts

- Trees and vegetation will be removed within the limits of construction.
- Existing non-standard structures (i.e. retaining walls, fences, steps etc.) within VDOT right-of-way will be removed and rebuilt on private property, as coordinated with property owners.
- Vehicle access to properties may be unavailable during temporary lane closure hours and driveway entrance reconstruction.
- On-street parking will be limited in construction areas.
- UDCD will communicate with affected property owners in advance of scheduled construction activities to coordinate work.


Project Schedule
